ORDINANCE #5/17

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 42/95 ENTITLED: “AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RESTRICTED PARKING IN FRONT OF ONE (1) RESIDENCE FOR USE BY HANDICAPPED RESIDENT”

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of West New York as follows:

- Section 1: Ordinance #42/95 is hereby repealed as it pertains to Luis Osorno, 332 61st Street #B2, WNY, NJ
- Section 2: The handicapped person involved has ceased driving since implementation of above mentioned ordinance.
- Section 3: The Department of Public Safety is directed to remove all signage for the spaces as directed by this ordinance.
- Section 4: All ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.
